GLOF ALERT-1

For Gilgit Baltistan and Chitral

Issue Date: 02 August, 2017

Issue Time: 10:30 AM

Due to persistent heat wave conditions in Gilgit-Baltistan and Chitral, the temperatures are likely to increase by more than 5°C from normal, which may continue for next 3-4 days. Melt rate will enhance due to high temperatures and expected localized heavy downpour which may trigger GLOF events in Gilgit-Baltistan and Chitral areas. People residing along the water ways must remain vigilant during the period.

Local communities are advised to remain alert and concerned authorities to take precautionary measures.
