Dengue Alert II:

Dengue may likely to subside in November; Next two weeks are still critical.

Based on the current meteorological conditions and anticipated future seasonal outlook and trends of atmospheric variables, it is expected that dengue cases may likely decline in November. However, the next two weeks are still crucial, as the prevailing atmospheric factors are favoring the conducive environment for dengue.
